The San Benito County Democratic Central Committee (SBCDCC) serves as the governing body for the San Benito County Democratic Party. While the Democratic National Committee (DNC) and the California Democratic Party (CDP) lead our national and state organizations, county central committees manage party affairs at the local level. The structure of each county's central committee, including the number of members and the election or appointment process, is determined by state law outlined in the California Election Code.

Membership on the SBCDCC is organized by county supervisorial district, with four or five seats allocated to each district. During presidential election years, committee members run for office in the primary election. Unchallenged candidates are considered elected without appearing on the ballot. Any remaining vacancies and alternate positions are filled through appointment, and the term of office is four years, starting in January of the year following the election.

The SBCDCC convenes monthly, expecting regular attendance and active participation from its members. Our objectives are centered around key initiatives, including registering Democrats to vote, supporting Democratic candidates at local, state, and national levels, promoting Democratic Party values, and making official endorsements or non-endorsements of Democratic candidates and local initiatives on the ballot. We strive to contribute meaningfully to our community by actively engaging in fundraising, voter outreach, and the study of pertinent issues on the ballot, as resources permit.
